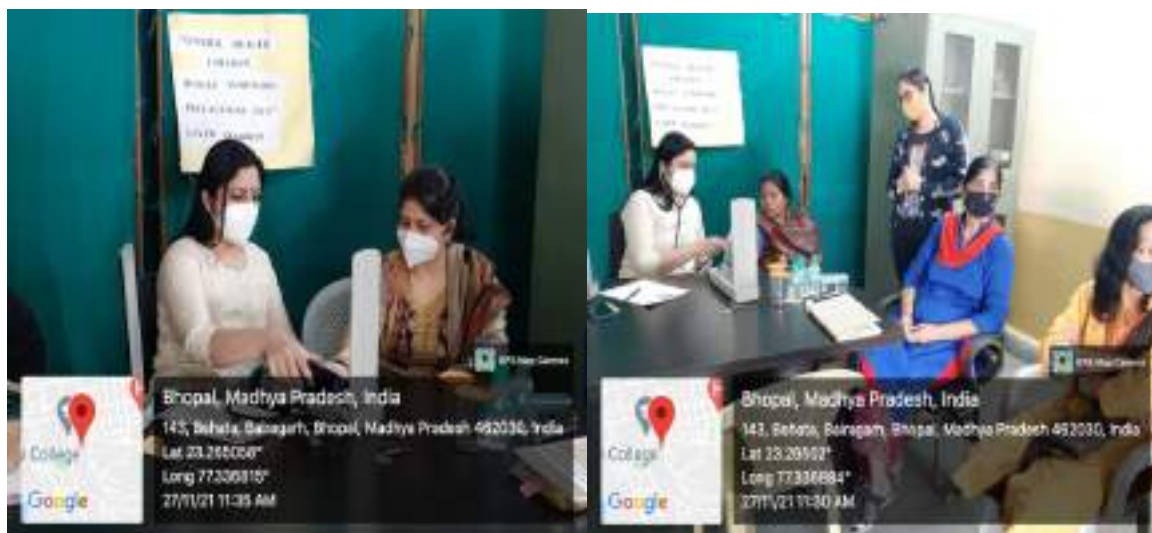
### Health and Hygiene Camp-(2021-22)

## **Sadhu Vaswani Ji s Birth Anniversary**

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The International Meatless Day was proposed on **25 November 1986**, the born day of Sadhu Vaswani. The educationist who initiated a mission to adopt the vegetarian living. He strongly urged the masses globally for adopting the vegetarian living. When he started the mission, he gained huge support and reached the big success in his mission.

Everyone accepted with his suggestions and became a volunteer to save and prevent the animals from killing. He makes the peoples understand that the animals and humans beings are equal in birth. Later, all the peoples had sent their vows to support the cause and go meatless on that day. To remember Sadhu T.L. Vaswani's birthday, every November 25 is celebrated as international meatless day. Specifically, Four Indian state governments as Gujarat, **Maharashtra**, Andhra Pradesh, and **Karnataka** have issued the notice for shutting down the butchers' shops on November 25.

Born on 25 November 1879, in Hyderabad, Sind, Sadhu Vaswani was a contemporary saint who began a career in academia and later turned educator. He founded the Mira Movement, with an aim to empower and educate women. Preaching love and reverence for all, he believed that all living beings carried the breath of life. During his lifetime he founded what is now known as the Sadhu Vaswani Mission, "a non-sectarian, non-profit organization which believes in the unity of all religion and reveres the Great Ones of all Faiths." The mission seeks to promote the philosophy that there is but one life flowing in all men, birds, animals, things animate and inanimate.

25th November 2021 Sadhu Vaswani Autonomous College, Bairagarh Bhopal, welcomed the 143rd birthday of Sadhu T.L. Vaswani. The day also marked the observance of International Meatless Day & Animal Rights Day. Sadhu Vaswani Centers across the globe organized awareness programmes preceding the birthday. Spiritual leaders shared wishes and supported the cause of Meatless Day.

Dr.A.K. Singh, Principal Sadhu Vaswani Autonomous College, Bairagarh, Bhopal in his address, spoke that Gurudev Sadhu Vaswani was a visionary. He would tell us, the time will come when meat eating will be regarded as a crime. On the occasion of Sadhu Vaswani's 143rd birthday, concessions were given at the Mission's healthcare institutions. Service activities included bird feeding, animal sevas, and distribution of ration kits to poor and needy families.







## National Youth Day 2022

National Youth Day is celebrated on 12 January to honor the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda. Swami Vivekananda's 159th Birth Anniversary is celebrated in 12 January 2022 at Sadhu Vaswani Autonomous College, Bairagarh, Bhopal as National Youth Day.

Swami Vivekananda is a name that does not require any sort of introduction. He is an influential personality who is credited with enlightening the western world about Hinduism. He represented Hinduism in the Parliament of Religions in 1893 in Chicago and due to this an unknown monk of India suddenly leaped into fame. National Youth Day is observed on 12 January to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda.

Swami Vivekananda founded Ramakrishna Mission on 1 May 1897 for one's own salvation and for the welfare of the world. Do you know his lectures, writings, letters, and poems are published as The Complete Works of Swami Vivekananda? He always focuses on teaching universal principles rather than personalities. He had tremendous intellect. His unique contributions always enlighten and awaken us. He was a spiritual leader and social reformer.

Dr..D.K. Dubey , Director Sadhu Vaswani Autonomous College, Bairagarh, Bhopal garlanded the photo of Swami Vivekananda and addressed the gathering. He asked youth to study the works of Swami Vivekananda, understand his ideals and follow them.

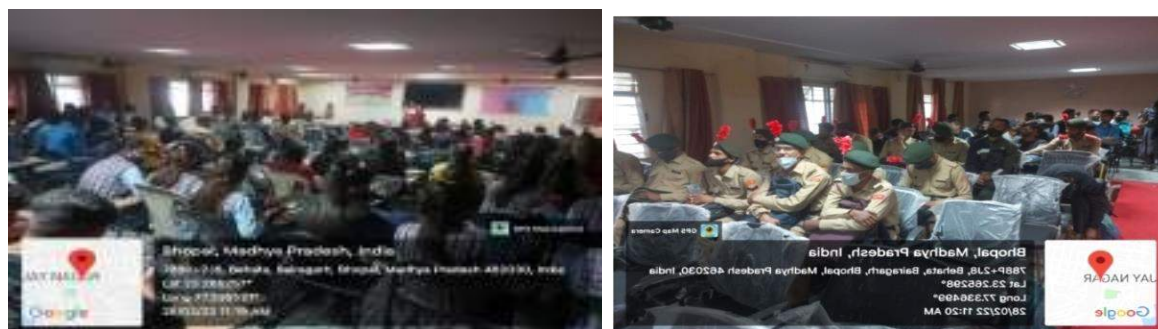
## **National Science Day 2022**

National Science Day is celebrated every year on February 28 to mark and recognise the contributions of scientists towards the development of the country. On this day, in 1928, Indian Physicist Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman made an important discovery in the field of spectroscopy, which was later named after him the Raman Effect. For his work, CV Raman was awarded the prestigious Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930.

The National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC), in 1986, asked the Government of India to announce February 28 as National Science Day. The government accepted and declared the day as National Science Day. The first National Science Day was celebrated on February 28, 1987.

National Science Day is celebrated to raise awareness on the importance of science. Educational institutions celebrate National Science Day by organising public speeches, radio, TV, science movies, science exhibitions on themes and concepts, debates, quiz competitions, lectures and science model exhibitions.

Sadhu Vaswani Autonomous College, Bairagarh, Bhopal celebrated National Science Day on 28 February 2022 to commemorate the discovery of Raman Effect by Prof. C. V Raman.

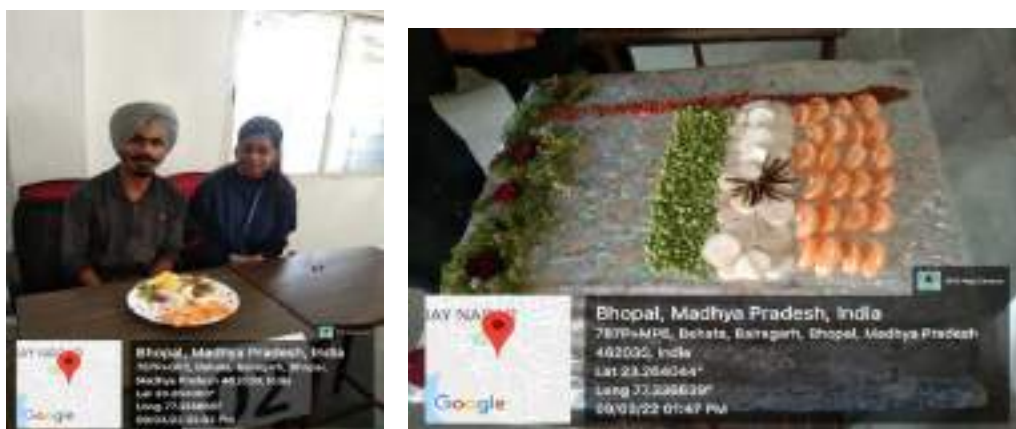

## **ABOUT SPORTS AT COLLEGE LEVEL**

Sport (or sports) is all forms of usually competitive physical activity which, through casual or organized participation, aim to use, maintain or improve physical ability and skills while providing entertainment to participants, and in some cases, spectators. Hundreds of sports exist, from those requiring only two participants, through to those with hundreds of simultaneous participants, either in teams or competing as individuals.

Sport is generally recognized as activities which are based in physical athleticism or physical dexterity. A number of competitive, but non-physical, activities claim recognition as mind sports. Sports are usually governed by a set of rules or customs, which serve to ensure fair competition, and allow consistent adjudication of the winner. Winning can be determined by physical events such as scoring goals or crossing a line first, or by the determination of judges who are scoring elements of the sporting performance, including objective or subjective measures such as technical performance or artistic impression.

Sadhu Vaswani College aims at all round development of its students for which it lays equal emphasis on classroom education as well as development of vocational skills, inculcating the sportsmanship in them and thereby developing them

physically, mentally and spiritually before stepping into the real world. It is for the fulfillment of this aim that the college has constituted the SPORTS COMMITTEE which looks into the physical development of the students as well as promotion of healthy competition among the students.

## **AIMS OF SPORTS COMMITTEE**

- Sport is a social tool basically aims at life quality improvement. This aspect is considered in its widest concept, blending the objectives of sports initiation, good physical condition, free time and inclusion'.

- Promote universal recognition that organized youth sports can develop positive attributes including healthier lifestyles, self-esteem, fair play and good citizenship.

## **FUNCTIONING OF THE SPORTS COMMITTEE**

- The sports committee functions by carrying out meetings of its members, planning and execution via discussion on a regular basis keeping in view the academic planner of the college.
- The committee maintains written records of all its internal meetings, decisions, plans, sports schedules, expenses etc.

- The day to day activities like learning and practice of sports are carried out in the guidance of the coach and supervision of the committee convener and members for the students in the respective grounds and the sports room.

- **Regular Sports:**
