#### > Scope

The policy shall apply to

- All the students who are engaged in research as part of their curriculum
- All academic and administrative departments of the college

#### Objectives

Objectives of the policy are

To encourage faculty to apply for recognition as research guides.

- To promote interdisciplinary research
- To provide research facilities in terms of laboratory equipments, research journals, internet facility etc. required by the faculty members and students
- To organize workshops / training programmes to promote research culture
- To encourage faculty to undertake research by collaborating with other research organizations/ industry.

- To encourage faculty / students to take major and minor research projects from organizations such as UGC, DST, DBT, MPCST and other funding agencies.
- The financial assistance /support will be provided to attend the workshop/Seminar/FDP.
- Faculty should be submit the Registration fees, Receipt/ attendance certificate/Two Geo-Tagged photos.
- For research publication, financial assistance will be provided after submitting hard and soft copy of research publication which is published in UGC Care /Scopus /Elesevier/ IOP Science / WOS /Ranking journals with impact factor
- To encourage and facilitate the publication of the research works in reputed academic International / National journals
- To facilitate the presentation of the research work through academic events such as workshops/seminars/conferences.
- To take initiative for granting study leave, sabbatical leave, duty leave, seed money, reduction in workload, etc. to deserving faculty members for advanced research
